#### **Price rises in September**

We have always tried to keep the cost of anything we charge for as low as possible as we fully appreciate that the rising cost of living poses many challenges. However, the increasing cost of resources means that we do have to make some unavoidable price increases to some of our provision in September. Where possible, we have kept prices the same as this academic year but please see below for the prices effective from September which includes some changes.

School lunch: £2.55

Breakfast club (7.45 – start of day): £2.50 (unchanged)

After school club (End of day -5.30): £6.75

After school club (5.30 – 6.00): £1.50 (unchanged) Nursery morning or afternoon session: £7.50

Nursery lunch session: £4.50 (or £2.50 without a school lunch)
