#### Toy Day - Wednesday 17th July 2024

Traditionally, the children like to bring in a toy to play with at the end of term for our 'toy day'. We recommend that this is a toy that the children are happy to share with others and is not of any particular monetary or sentimental value. We also ask that the children refrain from bring in electrical gaming items or anything that can connect to the internet. We do have plenty of games and toys in school if your child would prefer not to bring in an item from home.

#### **Department for Education attendance guidance**

In August, new attendance guidance for schools will come into effect and schools will be receiving increased input and support from local attendance officers. Schools have been asked to make parents aware of the new guidance and this can be found by following the link

Schools have been asked to share that, unless in extremely exceptional circumstances, term time holidays cannot be authorised and, according to the guidance, penalty notices may be given once a threshold of absence is reached. The guidance states: "The threshold is 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a rolling period of 10 school weeks. This can be met with any combination of unauthorised absence (e.g. 4 sessions of holiday taken in term time plus 6 sessions of arriving late after the register closes all within 10 school weeks). These sessions can be consecutive (e.g. 10 sessions of holiday in one week) or not (e.g. 6 sessions of unauthorised absence taken in 1 week and 1 per week for the next 4 weeks)."
