#### **Attendance**

As a result, she may contact parents directly if attendance is causing a concern or if attendance is lower than 90% which is classed as persistent absenteeism. She is also happy to be contacted directly to answer any queries and we are also happy to provide support wherever we can so please do get in touch.

# Flu immunisation

The flu immunisation team have visited school today to deliver the nasal spray to all pupils in Reception – Year 6 for whom we have received parental consent via the online NHS portal. If your child has received the flu immunisation, you should receive an email confirming that this has been the case and providing details of the immunisation. Please note that the portal is not coordinated by school and the spray has only been administered if confirmation was received by the NHS team in advance. If your child did not receive the spray and you would still like them to, details of the local vaccination clinics have been sent out alongside this letter but please note that you do need to book an appointment in advance.
